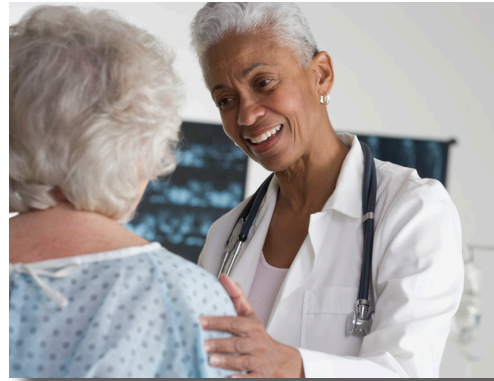

To find out if you qualify:

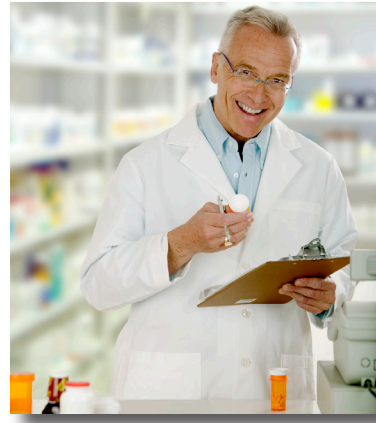
1. Know the names of the medicines you take.

NACo Prescription Drug Discount Card Program

Upon presenting your card to the pharmacist, you will pay the lower of a discounted price or the pharmacy's regular retail price.
